FY2012 TB Funding Outcome

- **5% funding increase for USAID TB**
- **Minor cut to domestic TB**
- **Global Fund level funded**

Congressional TB Caucus

- To be launched in January/Feb
- Co-chairs - Reps. Engel (D-NY), Green (D-TX) & Young (R-AK)
- Raise awareness re global & domestic TB
- May be bicameral
- Activities – briefings, appropriations letters...
- Reflection of congressional support

2013 Outlook

Pro's:

- Funding increase for 2012
- TB Caucus
- International AIDS Conference – July
- More child TB data
- Child TB in 2012 World TB Day messages

2013 Challenges

- Budget Sequestration – funding cut of 8% or more
- USAID TB program vulnerability w/in agency
- Need to work TB into “reducing child mortality” priority in US global health policy
- CDC domestic program vulnerable due to falling domestic numbers & sequestration

Advocacy Messages

- Over 1 million kids w/ TB in 2009
- TB - 3rd killer of women of reproductive age – thousands of kids left motherless or infected w/ TB
- Nearly 10 million TB orphans
- Women w/ TB 2x's as likely to give birth to premature or LBW baby

TB Messages

- Global TB pandemic poses a threat to the U.S.
- MDR-TB is increasing
- Will never reach goal of AIDS-free generation w/out scaling up TB control
- If GP targets are not met, 10 million lives will be lost to TB by 2015 - 4 million in women & children

- World TB Day – Op-eds, letters, social media
- Prioritize TB w/ Administration
- Congressional advocacy – Build strong TB Caucus
