CURRENT THREATS

MEDICAID CUTS Over a million LGBTQ+ people are currently covered by Medicaid and 30% of ALL LGBTQ+ adults quality. Medicaid coverage ensures access to key components of healthcare, including everything from PrEP, STI Testing, pap smears, gender affirming care, and even mental health care. Cuts to Medicaid's Sudget through the so-called "Big Beautiful Bill" threaten healthcare for millions of our community members.

BANS ON GENDER AFFIRMING CARE

The recent SCOTUS Skrmetti decision allows states to restrict or ban live-saving gender affirming care for trans youth. Along with other rulings, including Dobbs which overturned Roe v. Wade, this creates a legal foundation for states to interfere in our lives and the choices we make about our own bodies. 40% of the trans community lives in states with policies banning gender affirming care. This is particularly pressing for trans youth who face increasingly limited access to gender affirming care and high rates of poor mental health and self-harm as transphobic laws spread.

HIV PROGRAM CUTS

Within days of taking office, the Trump regime halted funding to HIV services worldwide - immediately shuttering clinics and access to HIV meds. His 2026 federal or Sudget proposes eliminating PEPFAR and USAID entirely, and cutting all funding for HIV prevention and surveillance programs across the US. These cuts put lives at risk at home and abroad and will upend the decades of progress towards ending HIV.

DESTROYING LGBTQ+ RESEARCH

One of the prime targets of the Trump regime has been LGBTQ+ research - the very basis for all progress we've made improving queer lives. Since January 2025, the US government has halted funding for research that specifically includes trans people, addresses racist health disparities, and explores underlying health inequities in marginalized groups. Some of the hardest-hit studies focused on HIV, TB, and hepatitis C, especially studies that partnered with researchers in South Africa and other high-incidence countries.

OUR SHARED STRUGGLES These threats will continue to target immigrants, communities of color,

women and femmes, disabled folks, and many others - groups already marginalized and vilified beyond their queer identities and experiences.

In standing up to these threats and fighting for our community, we must fight for everyone. No one is healthy, safe, free until we are all free.
